

Summary of the Number of Credits Taught by Part-Time Faculty: Spring 2008, Spring 2010 & Fall 2010:¹

Of the total number of part-time faculty “eligible” for the bargaining unit in Fall 2008, approximately *two-thirds* of the members had teaching assignments. Of those with teaching assignments, approximately one-half taught one course, one-third taught two courses, and some 13 percent taught 3 or more courses.

Of those “eligible” for the unit in Spring 2010, the proportion of the unit with teaching assignments declined from two-thirds of the unit to only *one-half* the unit. And of those actually teaching, a higher proportion was teaching just one course (64% compared to 53% in Spring 2008). Approximately one-fourth taught two courses (compared to 34% in Fall 2008). Ten percent were teaching 3 or more courses (compared to 13% in Fall 2008).

The picture for Fall 2010 was slightly improved as more members were given teaching assignments. *However*, more than two-thirds of those with teaching assignments in Fall 2010 were teaching just one course, compared to approximately one-half in Spring 2008.

Spring 2008: 560 credits taught by 108 individuals

1 course: 57 individuals (53%)
2 courses: 37 individuals (34%)
3+ courses: 14 individuals (13%)

Spring 2010: 417 credits taught by 91 individuals --

***Significant drop in overall number teaching from previous year;
Fewer members teaching 2 or more courses***

1 course: 58 individuals (64%)
2 courses: 24 individuals (26%)
3+ courses: 9 individuals (10%)

Fall 2010: 491 credits taught by 111 individuals --

Far more individuals teach one course

1 course: 75 individuals (68%)
2 courses: 24 individuals (22%)
3+ courses: 12 individuals (11%)
